GENERAL RULES

AGE: The age of an individual on December 1, 2018 is maintained the entire year. For horse show purposes, a horse has become one year older on January 1 following the actual foaling date.

AWARDS: Trophy to 1st place, ribbons to 6th place in all classes. Participation prizes to all Leadline & Walk/Whoa Exhibitors.

BREED CLASSES: Horses must be entered using their full registered name (and show name if different) for any Breed class. Please include a photocopy of your horse's registration papers with your entry or bring a photocopy to the Show Office to be left on file with your entry; presenting your original papers for review is no longer an option. Entry into any Breed class will not be processed until the required photocopy has been received. Horses entering an All Other Breeds class as a second Breed must have photocopies of all registration papers on file in the Show Office.

CAMPING/PARKING: Camper and trailer parking will be available in designated areas. Electrical hookups are available, but only a limited number have water hookups. Dry Camping includes tents, trailers, campers, and the like that are not hooked up but used for overnight stays. Anyone camping must possess a camping pass or obtain one from the Show Secretary. If a camping pass is not obtained, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.

CHANGES: Show Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes. Exhibitors will be notified if classes are combined or canceled.

CHECK POLICY: Checks returned for any reason will be assessed a \$50 processing fee.

COLOR CLASSES: Open to horses not entered in Non-Color Class. Horse must show a recognizable coat and/or color pattern (i.e. – Appaloosa, Buckskin, Dun, Grulla, Paint, Palomino, Pinto). Colorful qualities considered 40% of the total judging criteria.

CONDUCT by Exhibitors, Trainers, Owners, Owner's Representatives, Spectators, and all other persons present on the show grounds shall be orderly, responsible, sportsmanlike and humane in the treatment of their Horses. Unsportsmanlike or irresponsible conduct or any other form of misconduct that is illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating, threatening, harassing, or abusive is prohibited, as is the inhumane treatment of horses. Show Management may immediately expel offenders from the show grounds, forfeiting all prizes and awards with no refund of fees paid. Show Management reserves the right to reject any entry of any Exhibitor or Owner, or the participation of any Agent, Representative or Trainer, who has shown an objectionable attitude towards the Show and/or its Management, or who has conducted themselves in an abusive, irresponsible, or unsportsmanlike manner at a previous show.

DOGS must be on a leash at all times and controlled by owner. No dogs will be allowed in the Exposition Building or warm-up arena (except during the dog race).

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: **August 31, 2019.** Post entries are accepted after this date at a flat fee of \$15 per Horse.

ENTRY FEES are non-refundable for missed or scratched classes and will not be deducted from amount owing on Open Checks. Exhibitors will be allowed to transfer Entry Fees from one class to another provided the trade is submitted to the Show Office on the appropriate form. Entry Fees for classes entered during the show must be paid for at the time of entry unless a signed, blank check is on file in the Show Office prior to entering.

ENTRY FORMS must be plainly printed or typed and signed by Owner or Authorized Agent, the Rider/Driver/Handler, and any Coach or Trainer. Parent or Guardian signature is required if the Rider/Driver/Handler is a Junior Exhibitor. Exhibitor Numbers will not be released until all required parties have signed. Entries will not be accepted without payment for all applicable Class Entry, Post Entry, Office, Camping or RV, Stall or Tackroom fees. Open Checks cannot be accepted as payment for initial entries. Please circle only those classes you are submitting payment for. Riders/Drivers/Handlers sharing the same horse

must each be entered in the show on a separate entry form. Please include photocopies of your horse's registration papers if entering Breed classes. Please pay only one Stall and/or Tackroom, Dry Camp or RV-Hook-Up per Entry Form; do not split fees or pay another Exhibitor's fees on your entry.

ENGLISH DIVISION: Classes are open to Horses and Ponies and may be shown by riders of any age. Junior Exhibitors are restricted to mares and geldings. No cross entry is permitted between Exhibitor age groups. Unless specified otherwise, acceptable bits for classes in this division include: regulation snaffles (inc. twisted wire), curbs, pelhams (inc. kimberwicks), and full bridles. Prohibited bits include: gag bits, mechanical hackamores, and flat polo mouthpieces; use of prohibited bits will result in disqualification. Judges may penalize for non-conventional types of bits and nosebands. Martingales are prohibited. Different breeds showing in Open classes are to be shown according to their breed type. Refer to the USEF Hunter Division for horses shown in Hunt tack; refer to USEF Hunter Seat Equitation or Saddle Seat Equitation Division for attire specifications. Unless specifically prohibited by class rule, Dressage attire and tack may be used in English Pleasure classes.

EQUITATION DIVISION: Horses may be of any breed or combination of breeds. Junior Exhibitors are limited to mares and geldings. Senior Exhibitors may ride stallions.

EXHIBITORS must appear in the ring suitably attired, with correct number on their backs or on both sides of the saddle pad, clearly visible to the Judge at all times when in competition. Exhibitors in any 'In Hand' class may wear their number in front. Drivers may display number on the vehicle. Entries with wrong/missing numbers may be disqualified.

GATE HOLDS for tack/attire or horse/rider changes are to be requested at least 3 classes prior. Gate Holds are limited to a maximum of three minutes and are granted only when Horse and/or Rider/Driver/Handler are in consecutive classes. In classes where horses compete collectively, the in-gate will not be closed any sooner than two minutes after the last horse exits the ring from the previous class unless all entries for the next class are present. No horse will be allowed to enter the ring once the gate is closed.

GREEN (1st/2nd Yr.): Horses or Riders in their first and/or second year of showing in any division, discipline, or level of showing, excluding 4-H shows, schooling shows and Leadline and/or Walk/Trot 10 Years & Under. English or Western Pleasure Division Rules apply regarding tack and attire.

HIGH POINT AWARDS: Award & ribbon to Winner. All Exhibitors entered in the show will have points counted from all designated point earning classes. Horses must be entered in at least one Breed class for points to be counted for Breed High Point Awards. In case of a tie, winner will be the entry with the fewest classes. Points will be counted as follows:

2-8 Class Entries 9-16 Class Entries 17-26 Class Entries 27+ Class Entries

HUNTER DIVISION: Junior Exhibitor Classes are limited to mares and geldings. Acceptable bits for hunter classes in this division include regulation snaffles (including twisted wire), pelhams (including Kimberwicks) and full bridles. The following are prohibited: gag bits, mechanical hackamores and flat polo mouthpieces. Attire and tack to be in accordance with USEF Hunter Division rules.

JUDGE: The decision of the Judges is final. No one shall approach the Judges with regard to a decision unless he/she first obtains permission from the Show Committee or the Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

JUNIOR HORSES: 5 years & under (foaled in/after 2014)

LIMIT HORSE CLASSES: Horses that have not won six (6) Firsts in the Division being entered prior to the entry closing date of the show being entered. 4-H, WAHSET, and Schooling Shows do not affect status.

LOSS AND INJURY: I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition (Eddie MacMurdo Memorial) to the following: I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a Rider, Driver, Handler, Lessee, Owner, Agent, Coach Trainer, or as Parent or Guardian of a Junior

Exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm"). I AGREE to release Walla Walla Valley Horsemen and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of Walla Walla Valley Horsemen or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of Walla Walla Valley Horsemen or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) Walla Walla Valley Horsemen and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that Walla Walla Valley Horsemen strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that protective equipment cannot guard against all injuries. If I am a Parent or Guardian of a Junior Exhibitor, I consent to the Child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the Child's behalf. I AGREE that Walla Walla Valley Horsemen and "Competition" as used above includes all of their Officials, Officers, Directors, Employees, Agents, Personnel, Volunteers, and affiliated organizations. The construction or application of WWWH rules is governed by the laws of the State of Washington.

NON-COLOR CLASSES: Open to horses not entered in Color Class.

OFFICE FEE: \$10 per Entry (Horse & Rider combination). Riders entered only in Leadline, Walk/Whoa, Walk/Trot 10 & Under, and/or Showmanship 10 & Under classes do not pay the Office Fee.

OPEN CHECKS are a courtesy for Exhibitors that have already paid to enter the show who intend to enter additional classes during the show, with the understanding that classes once entered will be charged, and that missed or scratched classes will not be deducted from any amount owing.

OPEN HORSES: No restrictions as to Breed, Horse or Rider's age or accomplishments.

OTHER THAN HUNTER TYPE: No forward seat saddles, dressage saddles or attire and/or hunt attire; martingales prohibited. Roached manes and/or set or gingered tails are prohibited. Horses to be shown according to breed type and carry a pleasure foot in accordance with breed specifications.

POST ENTRIES: A flat fee of \$15 per Horse will be charged on entries not received/postmarked by the Pre-Entry Deadline and not entered in at least one (1) class. Riders entered only in Leadline, Walk/Whoa, Walk/Trot 10 & Under, and/or Showmanship 10 & Under classes do not pay the Post Entry Fee.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds the ASTM and SEI standard is required any time the Rider is on the competition grounds under the following conditions: 1) All Riders of any age jumping on the competition grounds at any time (including Hunter Hack and any Over Fences classes); 2) All Riders 6 years of age & under; 3) All Riders under 17 years of age showing in Hunter Seat Equitation and/or Pleasure classes or anytime Exhibitor is in Hunter attire and/or tack. No rider of any age will be penalized for wearing protective headgear in Western classes.

PROTESTS must be made in writing, signed by the protestor, accompanied with a \$50 deposit, and addressed to the Secretary of the Competition within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES (minus the Office Fee & Stall Fee) will only be made upon receipt of a Physician's or Veterinarian's Certificate, stating the nature of the disability, and presented prior to Rider's or Horse's first class. Refunds will be mailed after the show.

SENIOR HORSES: 6 years & over (foaled in/before 2013)

STABLING: Stalls must be pre-paid and are non-refundable for any reason. All horses using a stall on the grounds or staying overnight must pay a Stall Fee. Stalls are available from Friday at 10:00am through 6:00pm Sunday for \$60; one night, Fri-Sat or Sat-Sun, for \$40. If an additional night stay is needed, special arrangements, including the additional stabling fees, must be made with the Show Secretary. Stalls will

include one bag of shavings; additional pine shavings are available for purchase for \$10 per bag. NO CHANGE OF ASSIGNED STALLS PERMITTED WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION FROM THE SHOW MANAGER. No stalls will be reserved until payment is received with a completed Entry Form. Those desiring adjacent stalls must so indicate and, if possible, submit entries together.

STALLIONS may not be shown under saddle by a Junior Exhibitor in any class; Junior Exhibitors 16 years and over may show yearling and under stallions in open in-hand classes.

WALK-JOG & WALK-TROT CLASSES: With the exception of Exhibitors in the Walk/Whoa and Walk/Trot Riders 10 & Under classes, cross entry is permitted to Walk-Jog-Lope and Walk-Trot-Canter classes.

WESTERN DIVISION: Classes are open to Horses and Ponies and may be shown by riders of any age. Junior Exhibitors are restricted to mares and geldings. Entries may be any height and may be shown by riders of any age. Jr. Exhibitors 16 years and older may show yearling and under stallions in open in-hand classes only. No cross entry is permitted between Exhibitor age groups at the same show. Horses 5 years and under may be shown in any class in a snaffle or bosal and may be ridden with two hands. Appropriate western attire is required which includes Western hat or ASTM/SEI helmet, long sleeve shirt with collar (band, standup, tuxedo, etc.), pants (slacks, trousers, jeans), and riding boots with a heel; chaps and spurs (with or without rowels) are optional. Refer to the USEF Western Division for tack specifications.

Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the rules herein, the same shall be referred to the Horse Show Committee whose decision shall be final.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Arabian/Half-Arabian Native Costume Class

To be shown at a walk, canter, and hand gallop. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire. Decorations in keeping with colorful desert regalia shall be added to equipment. Attire shall consist of native (Bedouin) type costume including flowing cape or coat, pantaloons, head dress, scarf or sash. No object may be carried in either or both hands other than reins, a portion of an aba, and/or a riding crop or whip.

Command Class, English or Western

This is an elimination contest where any Rider not executing the Judge's exact command promptly and correctly is eliminated. Placings are made in the reverse order of elimination. Commands to be used may include, but are not limited to, walk, jog or trot, canter or lope, halt, reverse at any gait or at the halt, go from a gait to any other gait, counter lope or canter and to back up in a straight line or back into a reverse.

Costume Class, Open

Open to all exhibitors. Shown at a walk only. Be creative and fun! Winner to be chosen with help of spectator applause. Participants must furnish Gatekeeper with 3x5 card of costume description and theme.

Show Hack

A Show Hack horse is not necessarily a Dressage horse, nor an English Pleasure horse. Horses will perform at the collected walk, extended walk, normal walk; collected trot, extended trot, normal trot; collected canter, extended canter, normal canter, and hand gallop. Horses, while on the rail, may be asked to halt and rein-back. Appointments & Tack: Horses may show with a braided mane and tail. Braids may be secured with tape, yarn or rubber bands; decorations are prohibited. Bridle shall be light, show type, either single snaffle, double (full) or Pelham; Kimberwicke bit is permitted. Browbands and cavessons other than hunter or dressage types are prohibited. English saddle (hunter or dressage) is required; no cut back saddles allowed. Martingales, breastplates not allowed. Acceptable Hack attire is required consisting of conservatively colored coat, breeches and boots. A conservatively colored hunting cap, derby or protective headgear is mandatory. Formal attire consisting of white breeches, top hat and tails may be worn after 6pm. Spurs, whip or crop optional.

Walk-Trot English Pleasure

To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk and trot/intermediate gait. Judged on performance. English tack (Hunter, Saddle Seat, Dressage) required. Personal appointments not considered in judging.

Walk-Jog Western Pleasure

To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk and jog/intermediate gait. Judged on performance. Western tack required. Personal appointments not considered in judging.

MACMURDO PERPETUAL TROPHIES

The Eddie MacMurdo Memorial High Point Horse and High Point Exhibitor Awards are Perpetual Trophies and must be returned to the Walla Walla Valley Horseman Show Committee prior to the next year's show. In the event of a tie, each Exhibitor will keep the trophy for half of the year. It is the responsibility of the winner to have the next blank plate or line engraved with their information in the same style as previous winners. Winner will be presented a keeper trophy as their permanent trophy.

Eddie MacMurdo Memorial High Point Horse

Trophy to be awarded to the Horse/Rider combination accumulating the most points in classes throughout the show. Equitation, Showmanship, Jack Benny, Limit Horse, and Green Horse or Rider classes do not qualify for this Award.

High Point Exhibitors

Junior Exhibitor Walk-Trot 10 Years & Under and 17 Years & Under, and Senior Exhibitor 18-38 Years and 39 Years & Over, who accumulates the most points throughout the show. Halter, Limit Horse, and Green Horse or Rider classes do not qualify for this Award. Points for High Point Exhibitor Perpetual Trophies will be compiled on single Horse/Rider combinations.

High Point Green Rider

Awarded to the Horse/Rider combination accumulating the most points in the Green Handler and Green Rider classes throughout the show.

Breed High Point Awards

Prizes to be awarded to the Arabian/Half-Arabian, Paint Horse, Pony/Miniature Horse, Quarter Horse and All Other Breeds accumulating the most points in the show. Points will be counted on single Horse/Rider combinations. Equitation, Showmanship, Jack Benny, Limit Horse, and Green Horse or Rider classes do not qualify for this Award. Horses must be entered and shown in one Breed specific class to qualify. Horses with multiple breed registrations are only eligible for the Breed High Point Award in their primary breed division. (i.e. – for Horses registered with APHA and PtHA or AQHA and ABRA, APHA and AQHA will be considered as their primary breed and ABRA or PtHA as their second breed).

High Point Driving Horse/Pony

Awarded to the Horse or Pony/Driver combination accumulating the most points in the Driving classes throughout the show. The Pony Ideal Driving and Pleasure Driving Limit Horse/Pony classes do not qualify for this Award.

High Point English Horse

Awarded to the Horse/Rider combination, 17 Years & Under and 18 Years & Over, accumulating the most points in English classes throughout the show. Halter, Equitation, Showmanship, Trail, Jack Benny, Limit Horse, and Green Horse or Rider classes do not qualify for this Award.

High Point Western Horse

Awarded to the Horse/Rider combination, 17 Years & Under and 18 Years & Over, accumulating the most points in Western classes throughout the show. Halter, Equitation, Showmanship, Trail, Jack Benny, Limit Horse, and Green Horse or Rider classes do not qualify for this Award.
